Survivor-Driven Assistance

Collecting information from disaster survivors has been frustrating, fractured, and foiled by overlapping systems launched by competing agencies. No longer. Survivor Connect solves this challenge by deploying a system driven by the survivor.

- Survivors enter details about impacts from any mobile device, and then complete consent agreements for data sharing
- Agencies are vetted and agree to data sharing. Participating Agencies appear in a directory for survivors to review
- Supports multiple, concurrent events and incidents—including undeclared events to ensure regional efforts are supported
- Multi-lingual, mobile-responsive, compliant with assistive devices, and adapts to different kinds of disasters and incidents
- Participating agencies gain access to aggregated data to understand impacts and increase inter-agency coordination
